5\* Write a poem about insects suitable for publication in a magazine or newspaper.

8\*\* Take notes on a film or video that you have seen about insects and write up a report suitable for a class magazine.

9\*\* Write a short article describing a personal experience involving insects.

10\*\* Imagine you are a reporter interviewing a butterfly about its life. Ask about the changes it has experienced since it was an egg. Make a tape or write an article about your interview.

11\*\* Visit a museum. Find the insect collection. Write down the name of the largest and smallest one in the display. Write notes about the most interesting insect.

21\*\*\* After sunset, use a white sheet and a bright light to attract insects. Keep a record of how many different insects turn up. You may be able to use a camera or video to help you. Classify the insects into groups. Show your results as a table of data.

29\*\* Write a newspaper article about New Zealand's endangered insects. Mark on a map of NZ where they are likely to be still found.

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
