For each leaf, describe the area where it was found, with a photo or a drawing of the tree. Describe the natural habitat of each tree. Do not pick the leaves of native trees, use leaves that have fallen to the ground.	
4 **	Take a series of photographs of different trees to show the similarities/ differences of a particular part of the tree such as branching patterns, leaf arrangements, trunk shape/texture. List the similarities and differences. You may draw instead of taking photographs.	
6 **	Submit a plan for planting a flower-bed in your school garden.	
12 **	Make a terrarium using a bell jar or bottle. Use a variety of plants and make an explanatory display card explaining why you chose the plants you did and why a terrarium only needs a small amount of water.	
18 *	Draw a cartoon with a botanical 'flavour' centered on an endangered NZ native plant.	

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
