6	***	Name some of the types of scientists who would be involved in a forensic investigation and explain their roles.	
8	***	Blood, like fingerprints, is classified by types. A criminal has cut themselves escaping through the broken window and blood traces were found on the glass. How would forensic scientists determine whether the blood was that of the accused?	
9	**	Pollen grains can be used to connect a suspect to a victim or a crime scene. Find out what the study of pollen grains is called and write an illustrated article about how forensic scientists might be able to identify pollen grains and how this might help to identify a suspect.	
11	*	Collect samples of different hair and animal fur. Look at them under a magnifying glass or a microscope and draw what you can see.	
15	***	Take an imprint and photograph of four different types of soles of shoes. Make a "who done it" chart for these photos and imprints.
