# HUMAN BIOLOGY

## Sample Human Biology Activity Sheet

3	*	Why is insulin needed for bodily function? Draw and explain the feedback control system for insulin production.	
6	*	NZ has a high heart disease rate. Make a pamphlet or digital presentation listing 3 different heart diseases and explain what people should do to reduce the chances of suffering from these diseases.	
7	***	Make a labelled model of the human eye, explaining the role of each part.	
15	***	Find out how much sugar there is in 10 foods or drinks such as fizzy drinks, hot chocolate, snack bars or an orange. Use this information to make a display for your class with a picture of each item plus a small plastic bag containing the amount of sugar found in 100g or 100mL of the item.	
16	***	Using a real human tooth, if possible, otherwise a piece of chalk or limestone, investigate the effect of vinegar, soft drink, lemon juice etc on the tooth/chalk/limestone when left in the solution. Explain from your results what effect these substances would have on teeth. How does sugar contribute to tooth decay?
